- Pastor Mohan's journey here was a bit chaotic. He missed his flight to Little Rock because he took a nap that was too long, and there wasn't another flight till the next day. During all of this, the word about Jonah came to his heart. They ended up putting him on a flight to Memphis. The word about Jonah was for him because he was sleeping through the opportunity to go where he needed to go.
- God gave Pastor Mohan a prophetic word for our church: he began from the Bible: "He who has the key of David, he opens and no one opens, I know your works, see I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it..." (paraphrase from Revelation 3:7-8)
 - God is the God of order; He coordinates things so well; this is a season for our church, it could be years long; God has given open doors to really impact the next generation; these open doors are not just for ministry... they're for the intense presence of God. The manifest glory of God and angelic movement in our lives and in the church to make an impact. Take it up and enjoy it; grab a hold of it.
 - The leadership is not just passing the ideas and vision of the church, they are releasing the DNA of this church into the next generation. There is a great opportunity for the young people to see the Kingdom of God move powerfully. They are going to be amazing teachers, preachers, and apostles to the nations.
- While in Memphis, he felt in his spirit to pray for that city. He didn't know about the Grace Fellowship mission trip coming up this year. He prayed over Memphis like John the Baptist, that someone greater would come and bring signs and wonders.

REVELATION – PROCLAMATION – RESTORATION - MANIFESTATION

1) Revelation

- Revelation is like an uncovering; when God speaks to you, He uncovers something that was already in His heart.
- When God speaks, it releases God's vision into your life, which transforms your life.
- Revelation makes your identity and keeps your identity.
- God said, "Abraham, I will make your name great and through your seed all the nations of the world will be blessed"
 - He is still the most accepted person in the world (Christians, Jews, and even Muslims call him "father")
- When God speaks, it comes alive in your life.
- God's word is creative not just informative – Hebrews 1:1-2
- It will not change your destiny because it is already written in His heart, but it will take you to your destiny.
 - Rehman word: a spoken word into your life; a living word that can transform and change your perception of your life
- Never be casual about hearing God's word in your life.
 - Esau was casual about his birthright; he sold it, and he didn't take seriously what he had.
- Information frustrates, but revelations manifests in your life.
- God's word speaks about His nature and His purpose, just like when you speak, your nature shows.
 - God has plans for your future, and He will take you there.
 - There are great plans, and you must not let them go.
- Example: President Trump
 - He is unique; no one can compete with who he is because there is none like him. He cannot be compared to others.
 - Each one of us is unique, and we have a specific calling on our lives! There is no comparison between sons and daughters in the body of Christ.
 - You are special to the people of God! Realize that your calling is unique, and your calling is complementary to your brothers and sisters in the church. The Kingdom is together as a body.

- Testimony: there was a young man who was part of a tribal group. He had eventually met Jesus and became a Christian. This man went back to his group, and they wanted to make him the chief. However, the process to make him a chief was ritualistic and full of witchcraft. He said he would not participate in that, not for one second. He knew that he was of Jesus, and he was convicted to not take part in that, even though it was an amazing opportunity. People wondered why he was passing up such a chance, and they wondered who Jesus was. Eventually, after several months, the entire tribe had come to know Jesus!
- Jesus will be the center of your thinking, actions, everything!

2) Proclamation

- When you receive the word of God, you receive it by faith and proclaim it with confidence.
- First response to God's word is to receive it by faith so that it will have power to accomplish great things in your life.
 - Faith comes from hearing – Romans 10:17
- Prophecies over your life must be proclaimed and confessed. Don't be shy to share what has been spoken about yourself!
 - The enemy might try to tell you that people will get upset, they won't believe you, they will doubt you.
- When God speaks to you, it does not matter, you just speak it out! Think about Joseph and how he shared about his dreams.
- While you are proclaiming, he is taking you to the place but he is also preparing you on the way.
- Process of growth and maturity because you can't stay in the same place.
- You learn these things through the platform of life: people, emotions, and situations.
 - Life as a "university"
 - Your spouse is a wonderful professor/course – someone to teach you patience
 - People all around you are there to teach you how to love, how to handle emotions, how to help your children
- Story about how he raised his children: he never spoke anything negative to his children; he always spoke with love. He always says, "you are a good boy/girl." Even when his son brought a toy that had been destroyed and asked his father, "am I still a good boy?" and Pastor Mohan felt all the commotion on the inside, he still said "yes, son, you are a good boy." Then his son walked away with a smile. Speak only love to your children.
- How desperate are you?

- Woman with the issue of blood – Luke 8:43
- She wanted to activate a miracle; she faced death by trying to touch someone since she was unclean. She was desperate for healing in her life.
- How consistent are you?
 - Canaanite woman – Matthew 15:21-28
 - She was rebuked and rejected, but she pursued Jesus for the healing of her daughter.

3) Restoration

- Peter saw Jesus doing miracles, he received the best of teachings, he was the only person who walked on water, he saw the transfiguration of Jesus... but the same man who knew that Jesus was the son of God also denied him 3 times.
- We all have pressure in our lives; situations that can allow fear in that paralyzes us and we could give up the promises that had been spoken over us.
- We walk by faith, but we drown by fear.
- Peter's life is a perfect example of Restoration
 - Revelations about Jesus – Matthew 16:18
 - Replicate his master – Matthew 14:28-32
 - Rebuked Jesus – Matthew 16:22
 - Denied Jesus – John 18
 - Deserted and Depressed – John 21:3
 - I am going fishing
 - Grace (unmerited favor) – John 21:6
 - Jesus came and gave Peter favor still. It can make you strong, and you will come back to God and do great things.
 - God gave us incredible grace, so we can give it away too.
 - Condemnation/intercession – Romans 8:34 & Hebrews 7:25
 - The only one who can condemn us is Jesus, but instead He is interceding.
 - Jesus is both our judge and our lawyer; he knows our weaknesses and problems.

- He is the advocate for us; we will never lose a case.
- Jesus came to the shore – Repentance through Goodness
- Walking with Peter – “Do you love me?”
- Restoration of Motivation

4) Manifestation

- The Day of Pentecost – Acts 2:14
 - God said it’s a new beginning in your life.
- Peter: it is over!!
- Jesus: It’s a new beginning!!
- Seeds speak about fruitfulness, multiplication, and continuation
- These all pour into the next generation.
- Genesis 26:12-13
- Find the seed you are to sow: your talent, your time, your tithe.
 - Give your time, talents, and tithes to God. It is a challenge to invest because it comes back to the Kingdom of God and to the future generations. Let the word of God be a revelation to your lives.
- God loves with an everlasting love; He will never leave us or forsake us.
